Airport Commission June 14th, 2005

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Dee Grossman-Tasker, Acting Chairperson, at 6:00 P.M. Members present were: Chris Abbuhl, Ted Genstch, Jim Locker, Rich Varrati, and Grossman-Tasker. Sam Hitchcock, George Houston, Alan Welch, Mayor Brodzinski, Jim Zucal and Chairman Tom Farbizo were excused.

Guests included: City Service Director Gary Espenschied, Eric Hubbard, and Steve Slusher.

A representative for the Airport Restaurant was not present.

FBO Report

Eric Hubbard the Fixed Base Operator reported:

- Electrical repairs were made by Vance Electric for \$850.00 which was the quoted estimate.
- Security lights were repaired by Smith Ambulance in the parking lot at no cost to the city.
- Still searching for someone to repair some of the rollers on doors and hangars.
- The monthly cash flow report was submitted to the commission.

* A motion to approve the report was made by Mr. Rich Varrati and seconded by Mr. Ted Gentsch. All were in favor.

- A request for a repair of up to \$900.00 needed for an electrical board to operate the gate.
(This repair is necessary because of a lightning strike).

* A motion was made by Mr. Jim Locker and seconded by Mr. Rich Varrati. All were in favor.

- A request to continue technical support

services provided by Applied Technologies for a one-year period at a cost of \$495.00.

* Motion made by Mr. Rich Varrati. Second by Mr. Ted Gentsch. All were in favor.

Old Business

The lease agreement (including revisions), between the City of New Philadelphia and Airspace Place, LTD., for hangar property at Harry Clever Field was given to all members. All members are to review the agreement and bring comments with them to the next Airport Commission meeting schedule for July 12th, 2005.

New Business

RD Zande report by Steven Slusser.

- 2003 FAA Project – The Runway Safety Area study has been completed and submitted to Jeff Kramer for his review.
- 2004 Project – Has began on the hangar taxiway paving and reconstruction. Three soft spots have been discovered in the underlying sub-grade that require additional work. An increase of approximately \$1950.00 is needed to correct the problem. There is enough money in the grant to cover the additional cost.
- 2005 Project – New T-Hangar site. Bid documents were completed last week and bids will be opened June 28th, 2005, at 4:30 p.m.
- The Ohio Airports Association Conference is to be held on October 12th, 2005, in Columbus, Ohio. Information about the conference will be forwarded to the Commission and the City as soon as it becomes available.
